



Housekeeper wage rates

Effective from the first full fortnight pay period on or after the 1 July 2010

Issued 30 June 2010

In accordance with the Liquor and Accommodation Industry - Abbeyfield Society Supportive Houses - Award 2000

Full time housekeeper

38 hours week \$611.80

(\$16.10 per hour this is what is known as the Normal Hourly Rate NHR)

Casual housekeepers

(14.2.4)

(a)Monday to Friday \$23.19

(\$16.10 (NHR) plus 33% = \$21.41 plus 1/12 of Casual Monday to Friday \$1.78rate \$=\$23.19
(see clause 14.2.5 of the award regarding the 1/12)

(b)Saturday \$25.93

(\$16.10 (NHR) plus 50% = \$24.15 plus 1/12 of casual Monday to Friday rate \$1.78 = \$25.93)

(c)Sunday \$29.95

(\$16.10 (NHR) plus 75% = \$28.17 plus 1/12 of casual Monday to Friday rate \$1.78 = \$29.95)

(d)Public holiday \$42.03

(\$16.10 (NHR) plus 150%= \$40.25 plus 1/12 of casual Monday to Friday rate \$1.78 = \$42.03)

Relief Housekeepers

Clause 11.2 Relief domestic cook/housekeeper – A relief domestic cook/housekeeper may be employed to cover extended and programmed absences of the weekly employee therefore a person relieving the full time housekeeper Monday to Friday for 38 hours or more is paid at the NHR of \$16.10 plus 1/12 of the NHR rate \$1.34= \$17.44 per hour. The award states that if they have worked 38 hours Monday to Friday they can not work the following Saturday or Sunday.
